

## **First Nation or Municipal Government Dog Sterilization Funding Support**

Many local municipal and First Nation governments support sterilization of pets owned by members of their community. Some of these governments provided funding to dog owners as part of the agreement under the previous Spay and Neuter Voucher Pilot Project. There are no current agreements for this funding to continue as part of the Community Dog Spay Project.

Dog owners may wish to contact their local government to determine whether they can provide some funds to help pay for the spay surgery of dogs owned by residents. Some governments may also be willing to provide partial funding to neuter male dogs or to offset the cost of vaccinations.

Any of these arrangements are the responsibility of the dog owner. Participation in the Government of Yukon Community Dog Spay Project does not entitle dog owners to additional funding support from any local government.

We have provided a template form that may be useful for officials from local government offices to confirm that they are willing to be billed directly by the veterinarian if they agree to pay part of the costs.
