### Black bear shot, abandoned near Jake's Corner



Environment Yukon Conservation Officers responded to a public complaint received on August 25, 2015, regarding a black bear that was shot and abandoned at a small lake near Jakes Corner, north of the Alaska Highway.

Conservation Officers found the bear carcass near a moose carcass, from which the meat was taken. The bear hide however had not been salvaged and had spoiled. Investigation found that the bear may have been shot upwards to a week earlier.

Conservation Officers are asking the public for any information concerning hunters or other people who may have been in the Jakes Corner area August 16-25.
