Caribou Abandoned Near Dempster Highway



On March 29, Environment Yukon Conservation Officers investigated two shot and abandoned bull caribou at kilometer 191 on the Dempster Highway. A third caribou was reported shot and abandoned at kilometer 208 by a member of the public.

It is an offence under the *Wildlife Act* to abandon an animal and waste edible meat.

Conservation Officers are seeking the assistance from anyone with information related to this investigation or other hunting activity on the Dempster Highway over the Easter weekend to help identify the person or persons responsible.
