Four bull caribou shot, abandoned by Dempster Highway



(October 20, 2015) – On Oct. 15, four bull caribou were found shot and abandoned on the tundra west of km 461 of the Dempster Highway, near the Yukon/NWT border. It appears the animals were killed on Oct. 13, shortly after the Porcupine caribou herd showed up at the north end of the highway.

The meat was completely wasted. Conservation Officers believe as many as 12 caribou have been similarly shot and abandoned in the area.
