# Black bears abandoned by the Robert Campbell Hwy



Conservation Officers in Watson Lake are seeking the public's help for any information on who may have been responsible for killing and abandoning two black bears on the Robert Campbell Highway.

The Conservation Officers were advised on September 11, 2011 that the two decomposing black bears were at km 30 of the Robert Campbell Hwy, north of Watson Lake.

Based on an inspection of the bears, it is believed they were killed in early September. One of the black bears may have been hit and killed by a motor vehicle while the other black bear was shot and left with its hide still attached to the carcass.
