Caribou Cows Abandoned Near Dempster Hwy



On Sunday, April 18, 2010, Environment Yukon Conservation Officers discovered four cow caribou shot and abandoned one kilometer East of the Dempster Highway near the camp at Cache Creek (Km 130).

Abandoning the caribou carcasses in the field and allowing the edible meat to be wasted constitutes a separate offence under the *Wildlife Act* for each animal that has been wasted.

Conservation Officers are asking the public for any information concerning any hunters or other people who may have been in that area that day.
