



A case of meat wastage was brought to the attention of Yukon Conservation Officers on **Saturday September 18 and Monday September 21, 2009.**

Officers found two front quarters, ribs and neck meat from a moose dumped on the South Canol Road.

Later, they were called to South Access Road in Whitehorse to investigate the discovery of the back half of moose, cut into two butcher's quarters including the hinds attached to the pelvis and ribs. Pink nylon rope had been used to hang the quarters.

The officers believe they belong to the same moose.
