Muskox shot and abandoned by Dempster Highway



REWARD NOW \$2,000

A muskox was shot on Aug. 28, 2009, and left at KM455 of the Dempster Highway, between the Rock River Campground and the Yukon/NWT border. The incident took place between 9am and 12 noon. The bull had been in the area for four weeks.

Muskox hunting is not permitted in Yukon. All the meat was wasted. The Yukon Fish and Game Association has increased the reward to \$2,000 for information leading to the arrest and prosecution of the person(s) responsible for this incident.

Conservation Officers are asking the public for any information concerning any hunters or other people who may have been in that area that day.
